
Official statistics

- A lot of data and figures are generated on a daily basis, also in government
- Not every figure generated whitin the government is an official statistic
- Official statistics
 - Are of public utility and use
 - Pass the high standards of quality, independence, relevance and respect for privacy
 - => Production and dissemination whitin the scope of the European Statistics code of practice





European statistics code of practice



- The cornerstone of the common quality framework of the European Statistical System
- Applicable to all Statistical authorities in the European Statistical System
- Sets the standard for developing, producing and disseminating European official statistics
- Based on 16 principles covering the institutional environment, statistical processes and statistical outputs.

European code of practice -> Protocols

For Flanders: translated the principles into protocols

- Example: publication and dissemination
 - Release calendar
 - Standard release time
 - Separation of statistics from political comments
 - Preliminary access
 - Publication on the web
 - Methodology is made public





NCA as experimental statistics

- Demand of users
 - International framework
 - Thematic groups in coordination committee
- Development
 - Stakeholders
- Dissemination
 - Feedback / users
- In the future
 - Official (Flemish) statistic








Statistics Flanders and the Flemish Statistics Authority



Belgium as a federal state




Statistics: regional decentralisation

- 6th reform of the State 2011: devolution of the formal statistics competence to the three regions
- Creation of 3 regional statistical authorities: Flanders, Wallonia, Brussels
- Federal level agency (Statistics Belgium) continues to exist, but regional authorities on an equal footing
- Cooperation agreement for the 4 statistical authorities
- Interfederal Institute of statistics: the coördination of all statistical authorities

Interfederal Institute for Statistics (IIS)






Architecture: setup of Statistics Flanders

- Create of a fully operational Flemish official statistical system
- Decentralised:
 - departments/agencies of the Flemish government have responsibility for the production of statistics in their policy area
 - central coordination is task of the Flemish Statistics
 Autority
- Flemish Statistics Authority + departments and agencies = Network Statitics Flanders






Functional decentralisation: Statistics Flanders




Strategic framework

We stay informed about new technologies and developments in new data sources and statistical methodologies



Network Statistic Flanders



Flemish Statistics Authority (VSA)

- 32 FTE
- Services of the Chief Statistician
- Part of Chancellery Centre of government
- Report to Prime Minister
- Responsible for facilitating the coordination, production and dissimination of statistics (of/from) Flanders
- Position based on the Decree of Flemish Statistics





Operational aims

- <u>Coördination</u> and setup of a system for statistics development, production, dissemination
- Statistics development, <u>production</u>, dissemination
- Development and implementation of a coherent data strategy and –infrastructure
- → In each one a link with NCA is found: users demand, devolpment and dissemination, input from official Flemish statistic, becoming an offical statistic one day
