


The holiday season is almost here and so are MAIA's most recent achievements!

MAIA's contribution to the scientific research area


MAIA published a new research article on ecosystem accounting to support the Common Agricultural Policy


Social media and deep learning capture the aesthetic quality of landscape



A recently published MAIA-supported research article has been published in the Nature journal. The study has been conducted by a team of leading scientists amongst whom are the MAIA coordinator Prof. Lars Hein and project member Ilan Havinga, both from the Wageningen University The Netherlands, as well as MAIA member Patrick W. Bogaart (Statistics Netherlands CBS, The Hague, The Netherlands). The paper looks into how social media and deep learning can support significant advances in modelling the aesthetic contributions of ecosystems for ecosystem services (ES) assessments.
